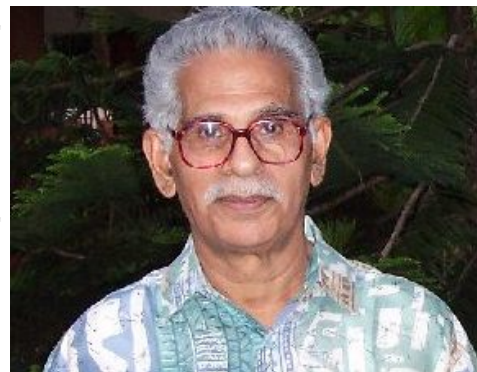

District Awards for the Club

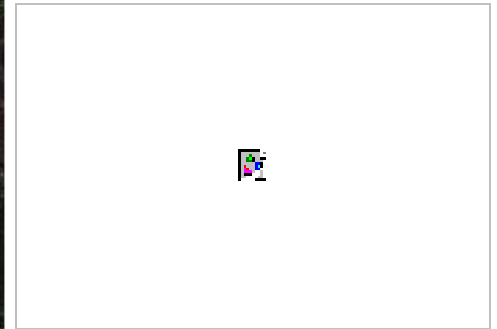
